RESPONSE TO AN OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

On 24 November 2022, you contacted the Ministry for Pacific Peoples (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) information regarding catering and koha.

On 25 November, we contacted you to clarify the scope of your request and on 1 December you confirmed that the request could be refined to the 2021/22 financial year and agreed to an amendment for the catering part of your request.

Please note that under section 15(1AA) of the OIA, if a request is amended or clarified after the date on which it is received, the department or organisation that receives the request may treat the amended or clarified request as a new request that, for the purposes of subsection (1), replaces the original request; the new date received for your request therefore becomes 1 December 2022, and the new due date for responding to your request is 19 January 2023.

I have outlined your specific requests and my responses to each below:

 How much has Ministry for Pacific Peoples spent on catering in 2022? Please provide total amount, a breakdown of the number of catered events/meetings this relates to, and what event/meeting/occasion the catering was for.

The Ministry experienced unprecedented growth in the past few years; such growth has been deemed necessary to meet the needs of our Pacific communities and improve their wellbeing outcomes across key indicators including health, education, housing and income. Additionally, this is the first year since COVID-19 that our Ministry has been able to hold in person events and engage with our Pacific communities face to face.

The provision of catering is significant to engaging the communities that the Ministry serves. It has a spiritual significance recognising generosity, mutual sharing and hospitality. By providing sufficient nourishment, Pacific peoples believe this embodies their fundamental ancestral cultural values of reciprocity and respect. It is also an appreciative demonstration of caring and love, that shows esteem and dignity for the people in attendance. Providing catering enhances the auspiciousness of an occasion, making an event and the messages shared or the reason for gathering that more memorable, also showing respect to Pacific communities that their time is valued, irrespective of their financial, employment and wealth status.

In response to this part of your request, you agreed to the Ministry providing the costs for the significant and/or larger events we catered and then providing an aggregated total for smaller community events, staff functions and staff meals while travelling in a category titled 'other'. We note that staff meals while travelling is not technically within scope of this request but as it would require substantial collation to sort through this data and remove it from the total, we have left this in, as agreed with you. Appended to this response is a table summarising the information requested.

• How much has Ministry for Pacific Peoples spent on koha in 2022? Please provide total amount, a breakdown of the number of koha this relates to, and what event/meeting/occasion the koha was for.

The Ministry is currently in the process of finalising this information for our response to the Annual Review. This information will be publicly released after the Ministry's Annual Review hearing which is expected to take place in mid-February 2023 at the latest. I am therefore refusing this part of your request under section 18(d) of the OIA as the information requested will soon be publicly available.

In line with standard OIA practice, the Ministry proactively publishes some of its responses to OIA requests. As such, this letter may be published on the Ministry for Pacific Peoples' website. Your personal details will be removed, and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you or your company.
